Norlight's new Milwaukee data center is equipped with UPS-protected power, including a diesel generator backup to prevent power failures from interrupting service. An interconnection between the data center and Norlight's SONET-based network backbone makes data transfer highly reliable given the backbone's inherent redundancy. Norlight also provides 24x7x365 monitoring of the physical data center and customers' connectivity to their systems as well as fully redundant heating, ventilation and air-conditioning systems (HVAC).
